¹ All material expected to be managed on-site must be identified on this form; a licence amendment is required if additional material types or quantities, not identified in this form are proposed to be managed.

² Specify if material will be mixed load (ML), separated (S), or processed (P); each phase must be indicated separately on the form (e.g. construction demolition waste arriving at the facility is a mixed load (ML), clean wood sorted from this waste is classed as separate (S), clean wood that has been processed into hog fuel is classed as processed (P)).

³ Specify the maximum quantity for each material stockpiled on site at any one time. Increases of the maximum quantity for each material require a licence amendment.

⁴ Describe the maximum quantity of each material managed at the facility on an annual basis. Annual quantities of "new material" (e.g. Class A compost of hog fuel) as a result of processing must also be described. Increases of each material accepted require a licence amendment.

⁵ Indicate, per tonne, the cost for the collection, transport and disposal or recycling of each material by a qualified third party; costs provided must reflect current market rates.

⁶ Security may be calculated by multiplying the maximum tonnage of material (Column "C") by the cost to dispose of or recycle the material (Column "F"); this must be completed for all materials listed. Processed (P) materials, or Separated (S) materials that otherwise have a positive value (e.g. metals), may be indicated as such, although the value of these materials may not be used to offset total security required.
