Business arising from last meeting:

- 1. Al-Ron Park, Ron may be in favour of turning area into a park, Paul has asked Ron for a dollar amount for the property. Paul and Mike to continue with dialogue.
- Wake Lake, Island Timberlands offered the South portion of the property (approx. 3 acres) to the CVRD at the same per acre price that was previously offered for the whole property. Offer declined. May revisit at a later date.

New Business:

- 1. The "J" property has approx. 30 acres avail at \$475,000. Committee took some time to discuss various ideas on this property but opted to revisit the idea at a later date.
- 2. Frank has a written rental agreement for the Glenora Trail Head Park for use when area is being reserved for private functions. Committee discussed this document.
- 3. Discussion on The Currie Park Easter Egg Hunt which will be held on Easter weekend, hosted by the Sahtlam Fire Hall members.
- 4. Waldon Park, a discussion took place on the possibility of the CVRD taking over the park and land. As per Loren Duncan, the CVRD would require a 3 year take over plan to transition the park into the budget.
- 5. Inwood Creek Estate Bridge, Mike made a motion to widen the access posts across the bridge to allow ATV's to pass again. Since the bridge access was narrowed ATV's have made 3 crossings in a fish bearing stream. Mike to post signs to discourage the creek crossings. Highways may be interested in the now closed Road & Bridge, discussions may ensue in the development of phase two of the project.
