Disposal Guidelines:

- **All waste must be disposed of at a CVRD Recycling Centre (Bings Creek, Peerless Road or Meade Creek)**
- No asbestos containing materials
- All loads must be secured & covered, unsecured loads may be fined
- Garbage must be free from recyclables, garbage that contains recyclables will be fined or rejected
- Garbage items must not be more than 1.25m long or weigh more than 100kg
- No person may deposit prohibited waste, call the Recycling Hotline for questions
- All dusty materials and fibreglass insulation must be double-bagged and securely tied
- Materials must be sorted into proper commodities and properly recycled when possible (ie. Wood waste, fridges or freezers, electronics)

Drywall is not accepted at CVRD Recycling Centres. However, drywall is accepted at private processing facilities within the CVRD and may be accepted at Victoria and Nanaimo landfills. Disposal fees for drywall are not part of this *tipping fee exemption program*. **Be sure to phone ahead** as special conditions may apply:
