

Course: **Acrylic Painting - Continuing 2022 – Suggested Supplies List**

Suggested supplies: This is a suggested list, not a 'must have' list. In my beginners course, the list of colours was limited to primary colours (Red, Yellow Blue) plus White, Raw Sienna and Burnt Sienna or Burnt Umber. For the next level acrylics class, I have added some colours that I believe you will have some fun with. As you explore and gain experience, you may discover your own personal favourites.

If you already have some acrylic supplies, but not exactly what is on the list, please bring what you have and we will work with it.

Even with a minimalist supplies list, painting is an expensive habit. If you are relatively new to painting, you may choose to purchase an all-in-one starter set that provides everything at an attractive price but be aware that such kits might be of lower quality.

N.B. Fluid Acrylic paints are NOT suitable for this course.

1. Brushes: Round #2 & #6
Flat or Bright #6 & #10
Fan brush (optional)
2. Paints: Titanium White
Cadmium Yellow Medium
Cadmium Red Medium
One of these Blues: Ultramarine, Cobalt, Phthalo, Cerulean
Raw Sienna
Raw Umber
Burnt Sienna or Burnt Umber
**Alizarin Crimson*
**Cadmium Lemon Yellow or Hansa Yellow*
**Naples Yellow*
3. Optional: small palette knife
4. Optional: Medium, small container of gloss medium for acrylic paint
5. Two Canvas panels or stretched canvas, primed ready-to-paint, 9x12, 11x14 or 12x16
6. Charcoal or Graphite pencil.
7. Optional: tabletop easel
8. Palette – N.B. small palettes with separate compartments are NOT recommended
9. Water containers, quantity 2, with caps or tops
10. Rags for cleaning
11. If you have a picture that you would like to paint, bring it to the class. It should be YOUR picture, *not* something from the internet, a calendar or a magazine. If you do not have your own picture, I will bring a variety to choose from.
