Directors Segall and McGonigle were both acclaimed to their new roles during the Regular Board Meeting of November 13. Director Segall has served as the representative for Area A – Mill Bay/Malahat on the CVRD Board since being elected in 2022, and served as Vice Chair to the Board since 2023.

"I'm so honoured and humbled to take on this role, and I'm deeply committed to fostering strong, respectful relationships with my colleagues on the Board to make the best decisions possible to represent the region and the communities we represent," said Segall. "It's the duty of the more seasoned elected officials such as myself to provide mentorship to my esteemed colleagues so we can continue to move forward as an organization and provide our wealth of services to the many people we represent."

These recent acclamations were made as a result of Aaron Stone, previous Chair and representative for the Town of Ladysmith, stepping down from his role as an elected official in October. There were no changes made to standing or select committees of the CVRD Board.
