

The purpose of proposed Bylaw No. 4621 is to amend the Electoral Area E –Cowichan Station/Sahtlam/Glenora Zoning Bylaw No. 1840, 1998 by modifying Schedule B [Zoning Map] of the Zoning Bylaw (No. 1840) to rezone the subject property from Parks and Institutional (P-1) to Primary Agriculture (A-1).
