

SCHEDULE H – HERITAGE DESIGNATION MAP

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Heritage Designation Methodology

Schedule H contains a map identifying Heritage Designations in the CVRD electoral areas. The CVRD Board has adopted an extended service bylaw that establishes services relating to heritage conservation. This land use regulation tool can be used to allow recognition of the historical value and character of certain sites within the plan area.

There are three heritage designation sites in the electoral areas as identified in Map H1 – Electoral Areas B/D/E.

Map Interpretation

Mapping schedules contain the following reference features: CVRD electoral area boundaries, parcel boundaries, Indian Reserves, and roads including primary highways (freeways and highways) and secondary roads (arterial, collector, and select local roads) as identified in the provincial Digital Road Atlas.
