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Transportation and Major Roads Methodology

The *Local Government Act* requires that official community plans map location of major roads.

Generally, major roads are regularly travelled by residents and visitors and connect major activity centres, facilitate travel within the CVRD, and support the movement of transit and goods. Major roads include highways, arterial roads, collector roads, and regularly travelled local roads and exclude private roads (such as strata roads), and resource roads.

Within the CVRD Electoral Areas, subdivision approval and road maintenance are the responsibility of the provincial Ministry of Transportation and Transit (MOTT). The source for major road network data is the Road Features Inventory (RFI) administered by MOTT. RFI data was retrieved from the Government of British Columbia GeoBC Data Catalogue.

Through consultation with MOTT, major roads are identified using the 'Summer Highways Classification', which accounts for average daily traffic in vehicles per day.

For Schedule T, major roads within the plan area are symbolized as orange lines and include all roads with Summer Highways Classification 1–5.

Map Interpretation

Mapping schedules contain the following reference features: CVRD electoral area boundaries, parcel boundaries, Indian Reserves, and roads including primary highways (freeways and highways) and secondary roads (arterial, collector, and select local roads) as identified in the provincial Digital Road Atlas.

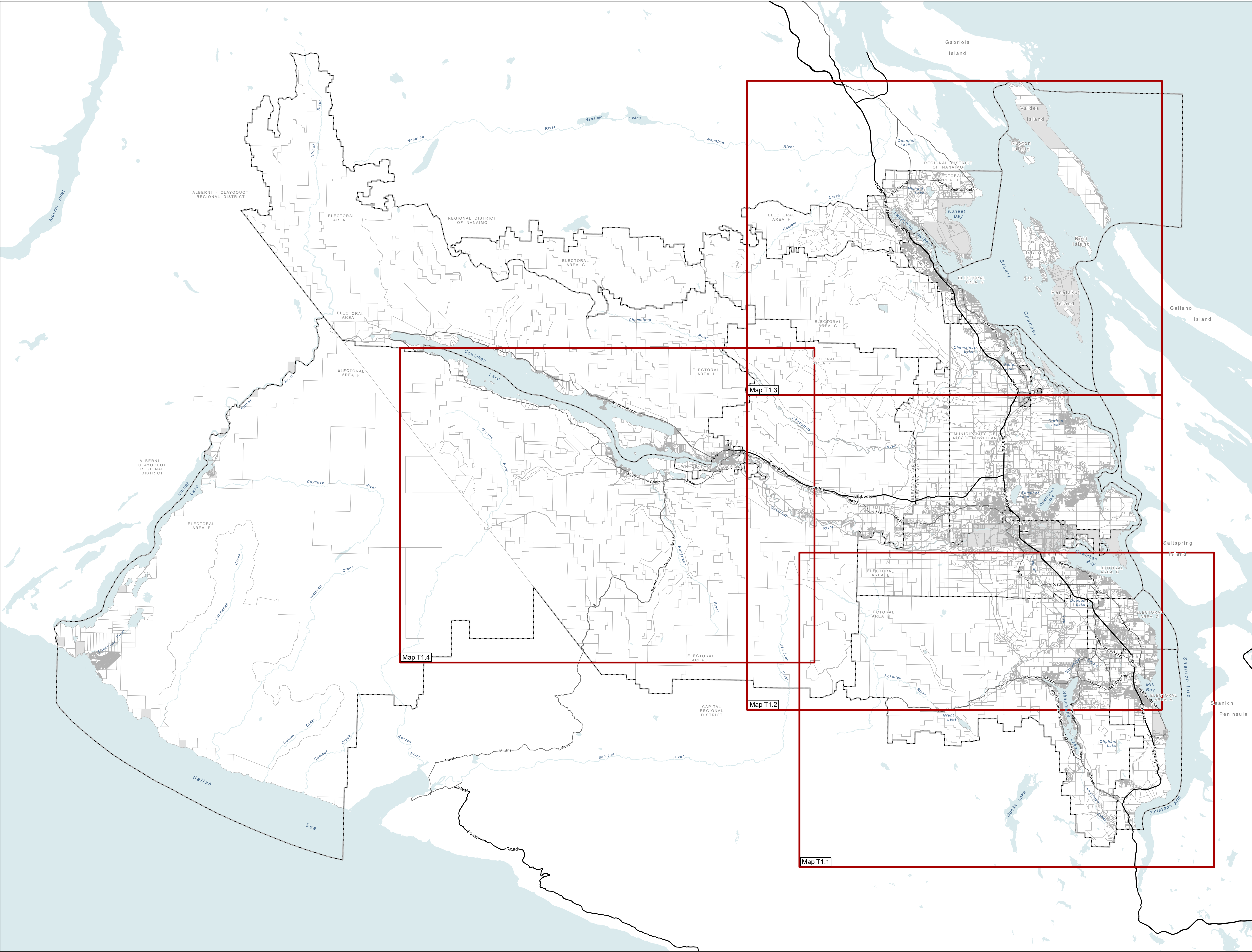

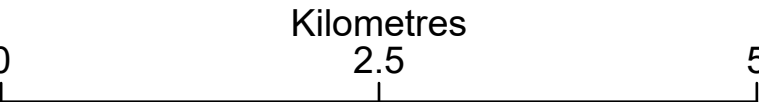
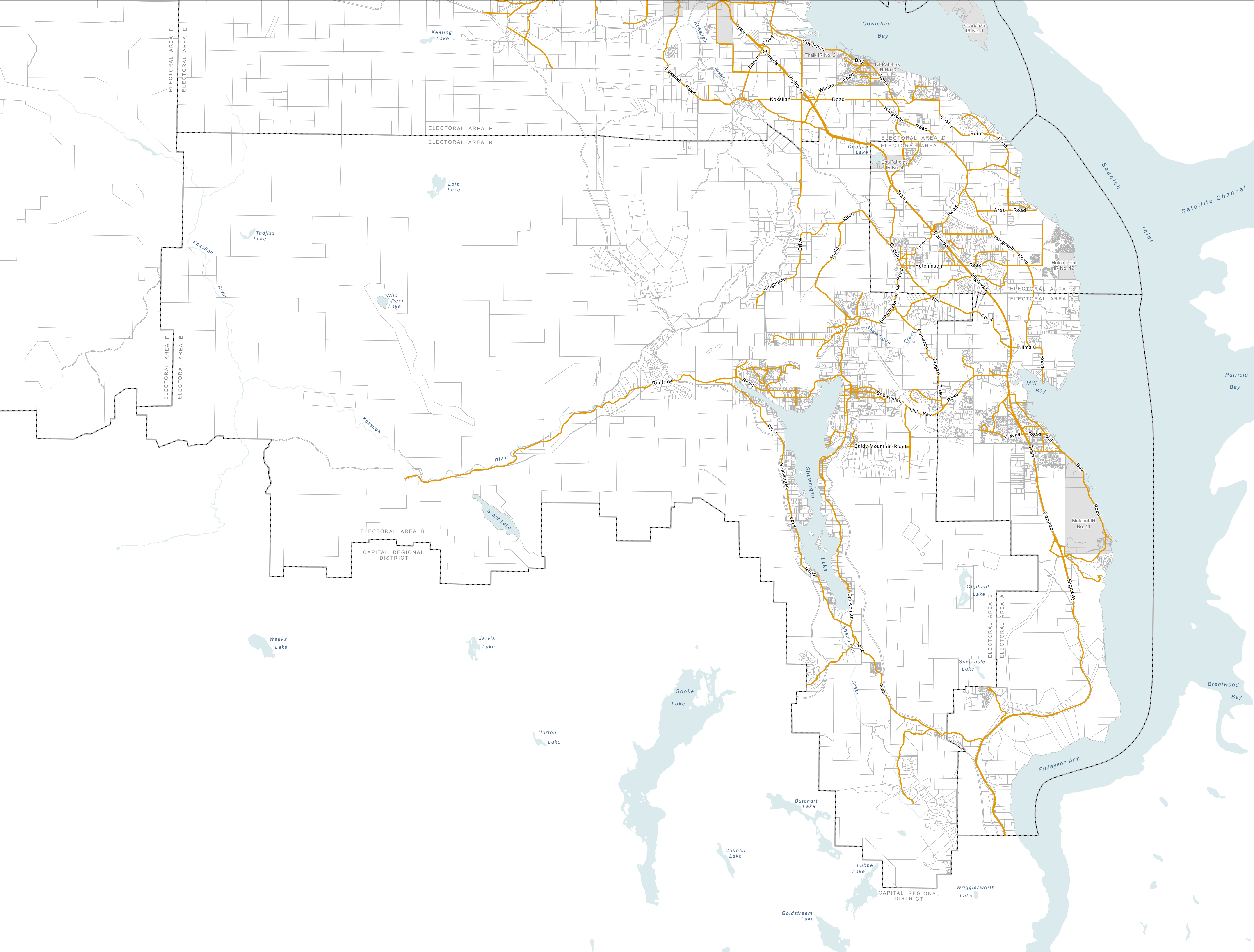

Map T1.2 - Electoral Areas A/B/C/D/E/F

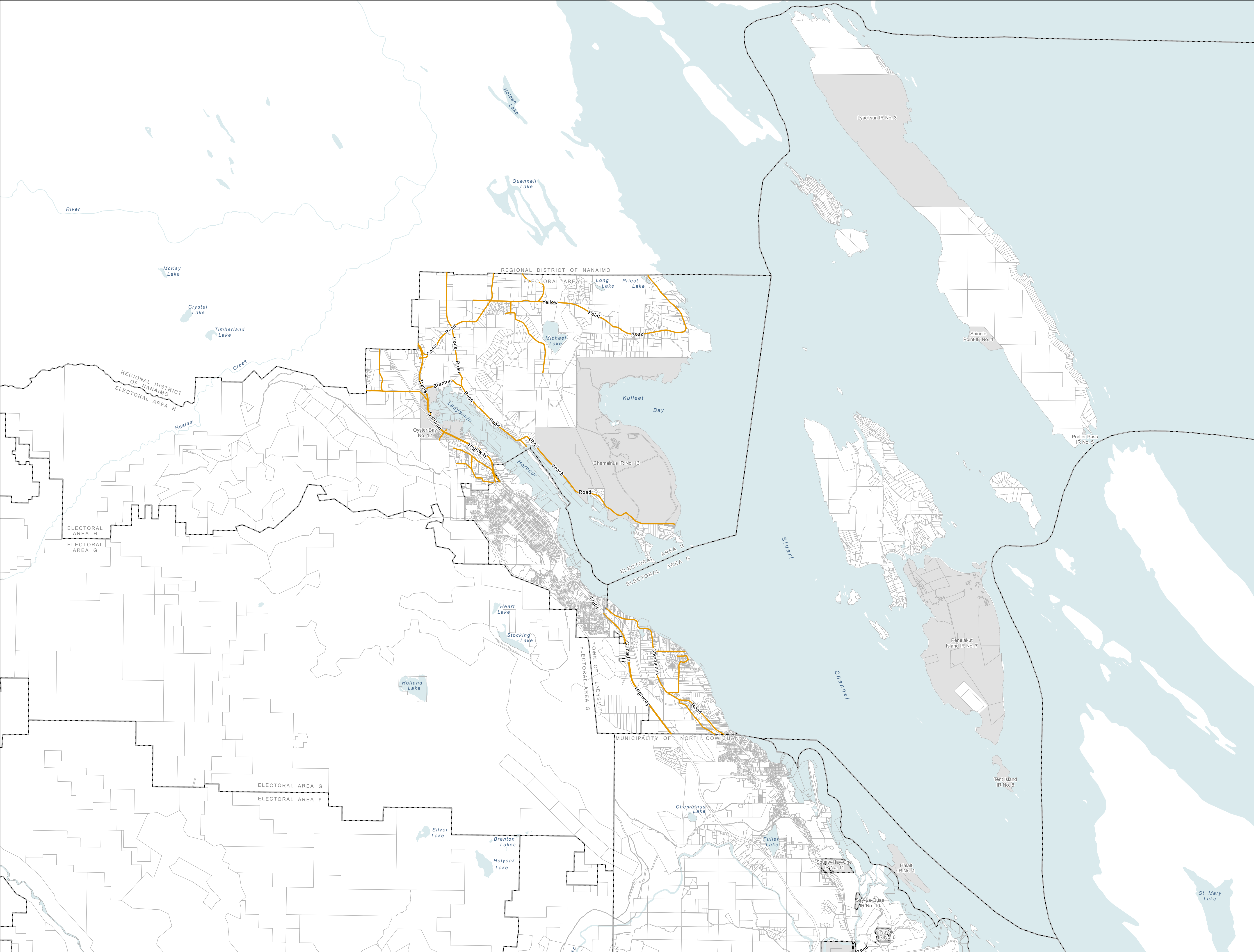

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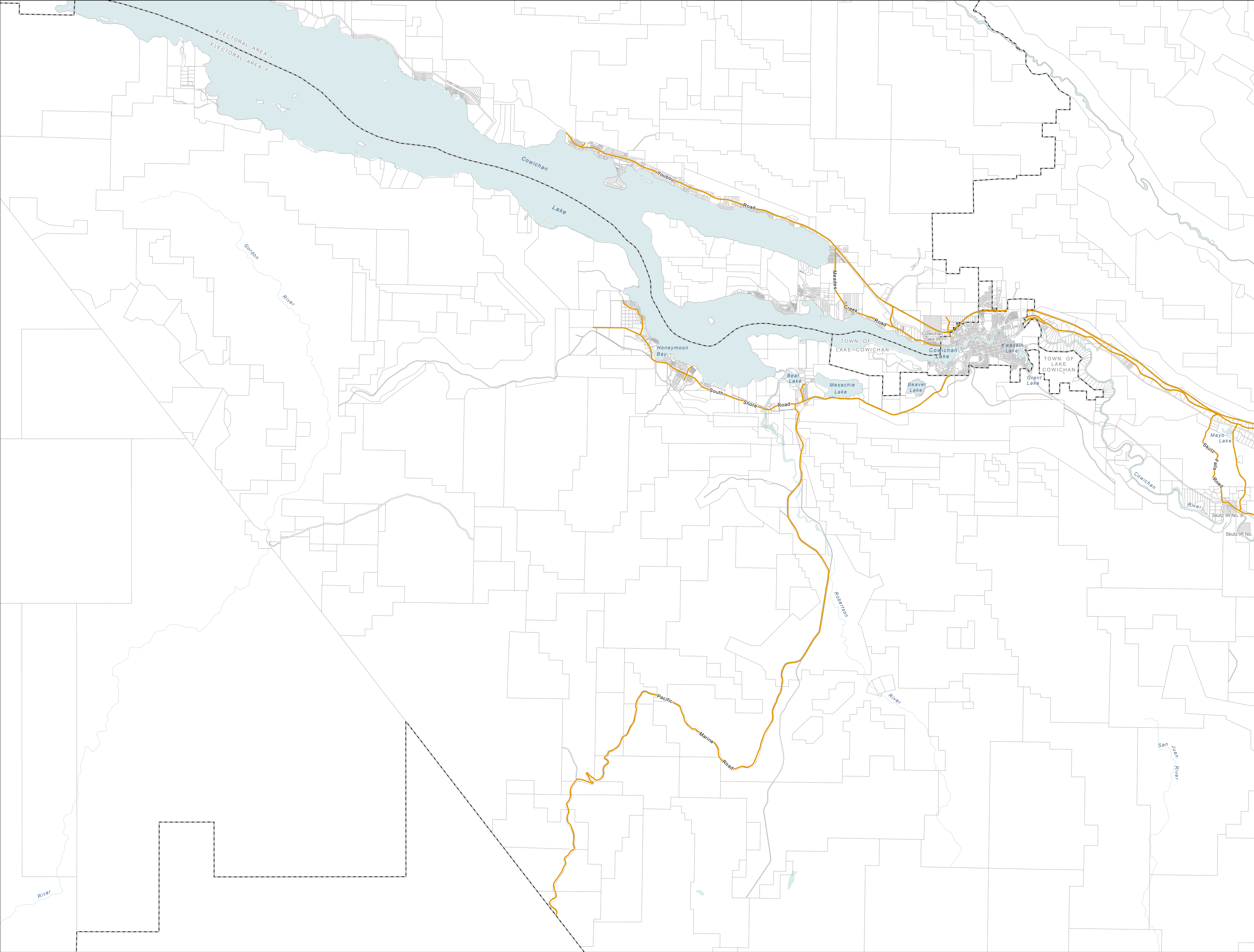
