Why? Bagged recyclables can't be sorted by automated machines and end up in the landfill. Keep recyclables loose in your curbside tote and take plastic bags to the recycling centre.

Recycling tips

- Place recyclables into totes loose; **do not bag materials** *Exception: shredded paper must be contained in a clear plastic bag or paper bag
- Place tote at the curb by 7:30 a.m. on your collection day
- Ensure recyclables are clean
- Be wildlife safe: avoid leaving tote out overnight
- Remove all caps, lids and spray nozzles. Plastic caps and lids can go in the tote once separated
- Flatten items to save space
- Ensure all items fit securely in the tote

NO! Don't recycle these at the curb

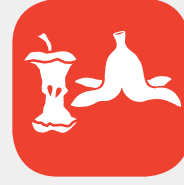
