

## Know The Rules Before You Burn

For all lands in Electoral Areas A-G (excluding Area F and Thetis Island), open burning is restricted:

• Open burning is only permitted from March 15 to April 15, and from October 15 to November 15

• Open burning is only allowed in GOOD BC Venting Index conditions

• Only untreated natural wood, prunings, or branches can be burned (NO leaves, grass clippings, garbage, or construction waste)

• Open burning must be located at least 10 metres from all property lines

• Open burning must not exceed 2 metres in diameter and 2 metres in height

• All burning must occur between 7 a.m. and sunset

Check the BC Venting Index for Southern Vancouver Island before you burn by calling 1.888.281.2992. There are many alternatives to open burning, all CVRD Recycling Centres offers FREE drop-off for yard and garden waste.


