



SALTAIR CENTENNIAL PARK REVITALIZATION USER SURVEY (2019)

The Electoral Area G - Saltair Community Parks Advisory Commission and the Cowichan Valley Regional District would like your feedback on any improvements or additions you feel could take place in Saltair Centennial Park within the next 10 years.

Saltair Centennial Park is a 5.85 hectare community park located in Electoral Area G – Saltair/Gulf Islands, between South Oyster School Road and Mountain View Drive. The park was first established in 1984 and had various acquisitions over the years with the last purchase in 2014, being the former Mount Brenton School property now the Saltair Community Centre. The park has been built up over the years with various park amenities: tennis courts (late 1980's), concession and washroom building (1991), original playground (1990's), roller hockey court (1998), north parking lot (1999), picnic shelter (2000), and the playground was replaced in 2009. Additional upgrades to the park have taken place over the last 10 years.

As park user's change over time, and these park amenities are reaching their lifespan, decisions will need to be made in the next few years on whether to replace existing amenities with newer versions or change them out for different amenities. In 2018, Saltair Centennial Park had over 28,600 visitors to the park which will continue to grow annually as more people wish to spend their time outdoors.
