

STREETLIGHTING CRITICAL LOCATIONS POLICY

Applicability: Engineering Services

Effective Date: November 22, 2000

PURPOSE:

To provide singular streetlights to critical locations within the Cowichan Valley Regional District.

POLICY:

That upon written request, and subject to BC Hydro and Electoral Area Services approval, singular streetlights be installed at critical intersections and sites for safety reasons in areas such as transit stops, hazardous intersections, schools, community and regional parks, and cluster mailboxes.

Procedure

- **1.** Advise the applicant of the Board's Streetlighting Critical Locations Policy.
- 2. Request the applicant to contact BC Hydro to verify if such an installation is feasible and what the cost would be to the Regional District.
- 3. Submit a request in writing, and include signatures on a petition from area residents.
- **4.** Advise the Electoral Area Director about the area in question and refer the request to the Electoral Area Services Committee for consideration.
- **5.** If the request is approved, staff would arrange with BC Hydro for the installation, and advise the applicant.
- 6. If the request is denied, the applicant will be notified.
