Cowichan Valley Crematorium Ltd.'s Request to Stay Consumer Protection BC's Licence Suspension – Dismissed

April 28, 2014 – Duncan, BC:

On April 24, 2014, Cowichan Valley Crematorium Ltd., made application to the BC Supreme Court to Stay Consumer Protection BC's licence suspension until their appeal in their action against the Cowichan Valley Regional District is heard and Determined by the BC Court of Appeal. The court dismissed their application for a stay finding that the public interest in this case in upholding the regulatory regime and statutory requirements weighed in favour of Consumer Protection's decision to suspend the licence. The gas-fuelled crematorium is to cease operation by 8:00 am, Monday, April 28, 2014.

Cowichan Valley Crematorium Ltd., and the Khalsa Diwan Society's appeal in their action against the CVRD is set to be heard by the Court of Appeal on June 9, 2014, in Vancouver, BC.
