WHEREAS life and property remain at risk due to flooding within the jurisdictions of the Cowichan Valley Regional District, Municipality of North Cowichan, Cowichan Tribes, Halalt First Nation, Penelakut Tribe, and the City of Duncan;

AND WHEREAS response to this flooding continues to require use of the emergency powers to regulate persons or property to protect the health, safety or welfare of people or to limit damage to property;

The Chair of the Cowichan Valley Regional District has requested to extend the duration of the declaration of a state of local emergency due to expire on November 22, 2021 at midnight.
