



HERITAGE REGISTER, CANDIDATES & POINTS OF INTEREST ELECTORAL AREA H – NORTH OYSTER/DIAMOND

Community Heritage Register

At the time the local area plans were prepared, there were no Community Heritage Register sites in electoral area H.

Candidates

There are three potential sites identified for the Community Heritage Register (CHR):

1. *Diamond Community Hall*: To be defined.
2. *Ladysmith Little Theatre*: Originally the Diamond Crossing School built in 1912, the Ladysmith Little Theater was transformed into a community theater in 2004.
3. *North Oyster Community Hall*: Originally a schoolhouse built in 1891, today the North Oyster Community Centre is a fully renovated facility. Located at 13467 Cedar Road, it is operated by the North Oyster and Area Historical Society.

Points of Interest

Sites of noteworthy local interest.

1. *Coffin Point*: This site is recognized to have old First Nations burial grounds, which are of cultural and historical significance.
