



## HERITAGE REGISTER, CANDIDATES & POINTS OF INTEREST ELECTORAL AREA I YUBOU/MEADE CREEK

### Community Heritage Register

1. *Youbou Community Church*: The Youbou Community Church is a two-story building with arched windows and an architecturally appealing peaked roof design. The church is nestled among the trees overlooking Cowichan Lake and has stood at 10648 Youbou Road for over 80 years. This historic place is marked by the Y-shaped intersection located at the north end of the building front.
2. *Youbou Community Hall*: The Youbou Community Hall is a large, two-and-a-half storey, white utilitarian building located at 8550 Hemlock Street. This building has a gable-roofed main building with a large shed-roofed extension at the southwest side and a small shed extension to the northeast. The front of the Youbou Community Hall has a partially enclosed porch on the main building and a covered multi-storey staircase on the large extension. This historic place is limited to the building's footprint.
