SOUTH COWICHAN RECREATION PARENT GUIDELINES FOR PARKS PROGRAMS

PRESCHOOL PROGRAM AGES 3 - 5

- Parents are required to stay at the park.
- We can accommodate a maximum of 10 children per day on a first come, first served basis.

PLAYGROUND PROGRAM AGES 6 - 11

- If you do not regularly allow your child to play at the park on their own, we request that you stay at the park to supervise your child.
- If your child has any specific health concerns that requires additional support, or they require a support worker at school for behavioural reasons, they will be required to attend the program with a parent or care provider.
- In general, school age children are free to sign in and out when they wish to, please discuss this with your child and the park leader.
- We can accommodate a maximum of 20 children per day on a first come, first served basis.

The park leaders are there to facilitate crafts and games, not to provide continuous supervision. The park programs is not childcare and do not provide a formal daycare structure.

PARENTS

- Parents must be readily available by telephone in case of an emergency.
- Parents must be on time to pick up their children. The park leaders have other programs to facilitate and are unable to stay later than the scheduled program time.

FORMS

An updated 2026 Parks Profile Form is required.

ILLNESS

If your child is displaying any signs of illness, please keep them at home.

SNACKS & WATER

Please provide your child with enough water to get them through the program. It is important that your child stays hydrated to avoid illness, if staff feel that there is a safety concern, your child will be sent home. If your child requires a snack during the program, please send a nut-free snack.

SUNSCREEN & HAT

Please sunscreen your child before they attend the program and encourage them to wear a hat for the duration of the program.

DISRUPTIONS

If a child is being disruptive to the group, a parent will be required to accompany the child to the program. If the disruption continues, the child may be asked to leave the program.
